<b>Overview</b>
This short video is composed of clips from home movies shot by Helen's family in 1932. It features Helen, her family members, relatives, and neighbors. Notice the views of the neighborhood from the corner of 15 <sup>th</sup> East and 17 <sup>th</sup> South in the background, the trolley, an old sedan, sheep pastured east of the Gully, and sledding off 17 <sup>th</sup> South.

<b>Time</b>	<b>Brief description</b>
00:00	Helen Carol Campbell with sheep, about 17 <sup>th</sup> East and Logan/Bryan Avenues
00:16	Helen Carol Campbell and grandfather, Wm. Jesse Groesbeck, shoveling snow @ 17 <sup>th</sup> South and 15 <sup>th</sup> East (note streetcar and old car).
00:41	Helen Carol Campbell and neighbor, Betty Robbins (Betty lived on 17 <sup>th</sup> South, first home east of 15 <sup>th</sup> East).
00:57	Helen Carol Campbell and father, John D. Campbell on 17 <sup>th</sup> South looking east above 15 <sup>th</sup> East (note streetcar, parked, end of line).
01:11	<b>Sledding:</b> South side of 17 <sup>th</sup> South above 15 <sup>th</sup> East, hill descending to area now known as Glen Arbor ~ Marion Groesbeck, aunt; Helen Groesbeck Campbell, mother; Wm. Jesse Groesbeck, grandfather, father of Marion & Helen; Helen Carol Campbell and dogs, maybe pets of Jack Robbins.
01:35	Many children sledding on hill, a popular place during the winter months
