00:08	Jean Anderson going up steps @ 1647 South 15th East (Note: Woodbury sign on S.E. corner 15th East & 17th South)
00:13	Tea party on porch 1647 South 15th East - Jean Anderson, Helen Carol Campbell (Note: I was called Helen Carol, my mother's name was Helen)
00:25	Driveway on 17th South (Note: fence borders alley, 17th South to Logan Ave, between our home and Robbins home on 17th South)
00:28	Looking east on 17th South above 15th East (Note: phone poles but no trees)
00:34	Summersaults on front lawn 15th East / dancing on driveway on 17th South
00:50	Maxine and Naomi Green (lived in bungalow on 17th South below 16th East)
00:51	Norma Parkin (lived in second home east on 17th South above 15th East). (Note: our home was on the corner of 15th east & 17th So. Homes east on 17th So: Robbins, Parkin, vacant lots, bungalow)
