8:18	Irving Jr. High. Supposed to go to Roosevelt Jr. High but didn’t want to leave Irving friends. Discusses walking routes to schools.
11:35	Hygia Ice Company. Delivered ice blocks to houses.

15:00	Sugarhouse Prison. Waved at prisoners when walking home from school.
